5 Bridges to be replaced very soon in Two mile Ash

After lots of lobbying by the Parish Council and placement or fault reporting Milton Keynes Council (MKC) have formally agreed to replace 5 of the wooden bridges within Two Mile Ash that have fallen into disrepair.

We have been Lobbying for this for a considerable time and collated our own report which we submitted to MKC last year.

So as you can imagine we are very pleased to have finally convinced MKC to agree to replace these Bridges.

The 5 bridges concerned are in a sorry state and could put Residents at risk in the future.

The 5th as you will see how-

ever this is not an adopted road so will be tackled via landscape and may take a little longer to get replaced.

4 of the 5 bridges are planned to be replaced this fiscal year but we are awaiting dates for the works to be supplied and confirmed.

The Bridges concerned are listed below:

- ◆ Haithwaite Footbridge
- ◆ Leaffield Rise Footbridge
- ◆ Clay Hill Footbridge
- ◆ Down land Footbridge
- ◆ **Clay Hill Footbridge (between Clay Hill & the Park) - Landscape are dealing with this one as it is not an adopted highway.**
