## MKC Begin Consultation on Resident Only Parking for Calewen & Kepwick.

We on the PC have had numerous complaints from Residents regarding inconsiderate parking, these complaints have been taken on board by Us and we have pursued MKC to action some form of Resident Only Parking restrictions on Kepwick and Calewen.

Both these roads Residents have been hit particularly hard by Parents parking in Residents drives or blocking access to their drives and parking

bays. This has created significant friction between the Residents and the parents.

As such we approached MKC last year about this issue with the proposal to apply for Residents Parking only restrictions to be put in place.

This month we had confirmation that MKC will be distributing a consultation document to Residents in Calewen and Kepwick with questions and opinions requested to be fed

## Consultation started to close Great Holm & Bletchley Fire Stations Merging into one Central Location

Consultation has commenced regarding the closure of Great Holm & Bletchley Fire Stations.

Bucks & Milton Keynes Fire authority are proposing to close both the stations above and replace them with one Fire Station at a new purpose built fire station costing £4.5 million, all the fire appliances will be relocated at West Ashland with Thames Valley Police.

If you are wondering where West Ashland is, it is on Groveway which is where the A5 junction with Grafton Street & MK Dons Stadium so very close to Beanhill. In depth details can be found in the links at the end of this article.

Consultation runs from **10am on Monday 14th September 2015** to **10am on Monday 9th November 2015**

A significant amount of local residents have al-

ready completed the questionnaire on the consultation webpage link at the end of this article.

We would urge all Residents within the Parish to comment on this proposal Before the closure date.

AHPC will be discussing this at our next meeting to formulate the Parish Councils Position and how we will respond to this consultation will be decided at the next meeting (22nd October 19:30hrs Ashbrook First School).
